




BEDDING PACKS

PROHIBITED ITEMS

ANIMALS

FAIRY LIGHTS

Unless battery operated

CANDLES/INCENSE/JOSS STICKS

Or any items with a naked/covered flame

CHIP PANS & DEEP FAT FRYERS

These are a high risk fire hazzard

CONVECTOR/FAN/HALOGEN HEATERS

Oil fan heaters are authorised

MINI FRIDGES

Medical fridges are available, please contact <u>broadgateparklettings@upp-ltd.com</u> to arrange, subject to condition

The above list is not exhaustive and provided as a guide only. If you have any concerns about an item please contact Reception.

Room visits are carried out twice a year by the Residence Team. If prohibited items are found during visits, this will be raised as a concern and a course of action will be agreed upon.

If your son/daughter wish to bring a rice cooker please ensure this is kept ONLY in the communal kitchen.

GENERAL SAFETY TIPS

- Doors should never be propped open (including fire doors).
- Keys should always be carried about the person to keep them safe. Keys should never be given to anyone else.
- Encourage awareness of strangers on the premises.

 If they are not sure who someone is they should ask
 them or alert the staff.
- Doors should always be locked when going out and should be kept closed at all times even if just nipping to the kitchen/bathroom.
- If residents see anything suspicious they should report it to staff as soon as possible.
- If the room is at ground level or easily accessible from the ground, remind your son/daughter to shut the window before they go out. Windows will only tilt outwards and should not open fully.

PREVENTION MEASURES

For safety reasons, our detection devices are highly sensitive and can be triggered by smoke, excessive steam or even aerosols. Close bathroom doors when showering. Never leave cooking unattended and always ventilate the area with the cooker hood and open windows. Smoking, vaping, naked or covered flames and deep fat frying are not permitted.

FIRE ALARM TEST



EVERY THURSDAY

IF ALARM SOUNDS FOR LONGER THAN 60 SECONDS, RESIDENTS SHOULD PROCEED TO THEIR ASSEMBLY POINT IT'S A CRIMINAL OFFENCE TO TAMPER WITH FIRE EQUIPMENT AND STUDENTS WILL BE FINED FOR MISUSE, AS WELL AS BEING CHARGED FOR REPLACING EQUIPMENT. DO NOT REMOVE THE TAGS FROM THE FIRE EXTINGUISHERS AND DETECTORS MUST NOT BE COVERED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCE.

ONSITEFACILITIES

LEVEL 1



Level 1 was specifically designed with our students in mind consisting of The Lounge and The Library.

The Lounge is a space that allows our students to relax and unwind with access to a couple of gaming stations, table football and comfy beanbag seating in front of a projector screen, whilst The Library has several study areas for both group and individual work.

LAUNDRY



The Reception laundry and Albion House laundry rooms operate on the circuit laundry app. Our other laundries across the site operate on a cash basis.

All laundries are £2 to wash and £1 to dry-exact change is required in the cash operated laundries.

POST AND PARCELS


