GENERAL SAFETY TIPS

Always carry your keys and keep them safe. Never give your keys to anyone else.

Be aware of strangers on the premises. If you're not sure who someone is, please feel free to alert staff.

Always lock your door when you're going out and keep it closed at all times, even if you are just nipping to the

If you see anything suspicious, report it to staff as soon as

If your room is at ground level or easily accessible from the ground, make sure your windows are shut before you go out. Windows will only tilt outwards and should not open fully.

If any fire doors are faulty please report this to staff.

PREVENTION MEASURES

For safety reasons, our detection devices are highly sensitive and can be triggered by smoke, excessive steam or even aerosols

Close bathroom doors when showering.

Never leave cooking unattened and always ventilate the area with the cooker hood and open windows.

Smoking, vaping, naked or covered flames and deep fat fryers are not permitted.

FIRE SAFETY WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW



IDENTIFY YOUR FIRE ASSEMBLY POINT (these are displayed in your flat)



IF YOU DISCOVER A FIRE



Raise the alarm and inform reception or the fire brigade without delay.

- Always treat all alarms as serious if they sound for longer than 60 seconds.
- Evacuate the building as quickly as possible.
- Make sure your flat mates have heard the alarm.
- Make your way quickly to the fire assembly point.
- Do not re-enter the building until it has been declared safe to do so.

FIRE ALARM TEST



Fire alarms will be tested on a weekly basis every Thursday. You will not have to evacuate the building unless the alarm continues to sound for more that 60 seconds. In this case follow the evacuation procedures to the assembly point.

FIRE EQUIPMENT

Emergency equipment is in place for the safety of all residents. Tampering with emergency equipment i.e. fire alarms, emergency exits (wedging open flat doors), covering detectors are serious criminal acts which not only have potential to endanger lives but invalidate your insurance.

Acts of this nature are in breach of your licence agreement and may result in your removal from your accommodation. Residents and guests are reminded of the importance of fire doors. Should you discover any faults or damage please report immediately via the Home@Halls App or visit reception in person.



FIRE DOORS SHOULD REMAIN CLOSED AT ALL TIMES AND SHOULD NOT BE WEDGED OPEN. DOING SO WILL POSE A SERIOUS SECURITY AND FIRE RISK. SHOULD YOU BECOME AWARE OF A FIRE OR A HAZARD THAT COULD DEVELOP INTO A FIRE, PLEASE CONTACT RECEPTION IMMEDIATELY



LAUNDRY



Our main laundry is located next to the reception.

All of the laundry rooms operate on the Circuit Go app or you can use the payment machines in the laundry.

All laundries are £3.50 to wash and £1.50 to dry.





POST AND PARCELS



Each flat has a shared mailbox which Royal Mail can access for delivery of letters and small parcels. Always include a contact number for packages so delivery drivers can contact you. For delivery to our amazon vine locker (located in the amenities building) add 'vine' to your address book. If the UniDrop multi courier parcel locker has been used for your deliveries you will be notified by text.

BIKE STORAGE



We have multiple bike storage areas across site.

Please come to the reception to register and get a
tag for your bike.

You will then be given access via your block access card. Only students using the bike sheds have access.

Bike storage is free to all students.

PARKING



Parking permits are available for £300 per year.




